The DD Travel Hammock / Bivi is a truly versatile product for adventurers on the go. With the same construction as the Popular DD Frontline Hammock, this has one key difference – the lower layer is made from the same fully waterproof material as our range of DD Tarps, allowing dual usage as both a comfortable hammock, and an insect-proof ground bivi.

Features

- **Dual layer** design – breathable top layer with a waterproof base layer.
- Allows for usage as both a **hammock** and a **ground bivi**
- **Ultra-fine mesh mosquito net** built in to protect against insects (even the smallest!)
- **4 internal pouch pockets** for storage of valuables and essentials
- **4 accessory loops**, for attachment of the DD Underblanket, or smaller accessories such as the DD Beer Holder
- **2 loops on the inside of the net**, to allow for the attachment of torches, accessories or the DD Hanging Pocket
- **Double sided zippers** on the mosquito net for easy entry and exit
- Pre-fitted with 10m of **DD Strong Webbing** – ready to set up straight out of the bag
- Compact stuff **sack**



How does it work?

You can use this product as both a comfortable hammock, or on the ground as a bivi. You can customise the set-up between 100% insect-free, or free and open in whichever configuration you use.

Set-Up Options

Bug free hammock

Completely insect and mosquito free sleeping system

To lift the bug net up - simply tie one end of the elastic cord (included) to the central loop near the spreader pole sleeves, another end can be tied to either suspension, tarp or tree.

To spread out the mosquito net creating more room inside the hammock - insert the spreader poles into the sleeves.

Tie the mosquito net up above the hammock if it is not needed.



Basic open hammock

To lie out in the open simply flip the hammock over so the mosquito net is underneath (please remove the mosquito net poles before doing this).

Using it this way you can also use it as a seat during the day.



Ground Bivi Configuration

To set up the DD Travel Hammock / Bivi on the ground (making sure the area is free of sharp rocks or sticks etc) lay out the hammock flat, and use pegs to peg out the 4 accessory loops into the ground. The suspension webbing can also be pegged out on either end to create further space.

With the spreader poles in place in the sleeves, and elastic cord attached in the same way as with the hammock, tie off the elastic cord to a tree, pole or Hiking Pole on either side to raise the mosquito net from the ground. You can then unzip the mosquito net and climb inside, taking advantage of the waterproof groundsheet!

Please note – to make the bivi waterproof from above, we recommend setting a tarp up overhead, creating a fully insect and weatherproof system.
